<p><b>Competition</b></p> <p>The competition starts with a running course, between the running courses a series of 4 arrows (U10-U15: 3 arrows) must be shot. There will be one penalty round per missed shot. Each participant must have 12 arrows (U10-U15: 9 arrows) available, as all arrows will be drawn after the entire run. Participants must carry the bow while running. The relays will be combined in the classes up to U15 and from U18. A relay consists of 3 athletes of one club. If additional weights are mounted on the bow, their length must not exceed 10 cm.</p> <p><u>Traditional bow</u></p> <p>The class "Traditional" includes (besides Traditional according to DSB) also hunting bow, longbow, primitive bow and composite bow.</p>

<p>Arrows may be carried in a back quiver while running. A frame mounted on the bow for carrying the bow on the back and a device for carrying arrows on the bow are permitted for both types of bows.</p>																	

The arrows must be securely and firmly attached to the bow or back quiver, even in the event of a fall. If a carrying rack is mounted on the bow, the bow must be carried on the back in the running round.

If a class is not opened, those entered will be assigned to other (higher) classes. The combination of standard and traditional bows in one age class is possible in exceptional cases, in which case each starter will receive his/her corresponding edition.

The distance of the penalty lap is 15% of the running lap in each case.

All participants of the U-classes pay 20,00€, all participants of the other classes pay 35,00€. The team fee (relay) is 20,00€ and will be paid on site.

### Important Informations

1. The technical commission as well as the jury will be appointed by the organizing team DBSV/DSB.
2. The equipment control will be carried out during the shooting-in.
3. A fee of 25.00€ is set for objections and their handling; it is forfeited if the objection is not upheld.

4. No changes of bow class, club affiliation and age class are possible after the entry deadline.
5. With the participation in the championship the participants agree with the electronic storage of the competition-relevant data and the publication of start lists, results, photos and videos in notices, publicly accessible print and digital media as well as publications of the DBSV and DSB as well as their national federations.
